
Rationale for Budget Model Revision

- CSU is experiencing success, but we need to work to address our future
- The higher education landscape is changing
- CSU's existing incremental budget model limits flexibility, adaptability, and innovation
- A new budget model can provide new opportunities for renewal of our mission
- Primary goal of a change is to enable delivery of continued educational and research excellence

 Executive leaders who will set direction, make decisions (President/CFO/Provost/Chair FC/Executive VP)


Steering Committee:

- Department Chairs (representing those who are especially affected by a budget model change)


Technical Committee:
